*Registrations not paid in full by January 14, 2010 will receive a \$50 additional fee. All registrations made after January 14, 2010 will be \$650 due to a late registration fee of \$50 and be given 60 days to pay the account in full. Reservations are on a first-come, first served basis and will only be held with the required deposit per participant. Payments can be made in person, by mail, on-line or by phone. All payments must ARRIVE by the date stated or the fees and reserved spot will be forfeited. These fees are valid only for the 2010 CHASE season.*

**Refund Policy**

CHASE continually sells out, 100%, and year after year. Thus, the following refund policy must be adhered to: Fees will not be refunded unless there is a death in the immediate family or severe illness of the participant (must be accompanied by a doctor's letter). It is important to understand that when you make a reservation at CHASE you are committing to pay for the full fee for that slot. Slots are transferable to another participant, but fees paid will not be credited to another slot. Slots booked are expected to be paid in full. ## CHASE Requirements

All participants must be 13 as of January 1, 2010, must be able to successfully pass the Boy Scout of America swim test, and have a completed and **current BSA medical** form. One of these forms, per participants must be completed within two weeks of making registration or registration will be forfeited. CHASE risk advisory

Parents, guardians and potential participants in CHASE programs are advised that participation can involve exposure to accident, illness, and /or injury associated with heat, and physically demanding activity, associated with a high adventure program sailing on the Chesapeake Bay. Campers may be exposed occasional severe weather conditions such as lightening, high heat, high humidity, heavy rain, hail, and other weather related issues. Other accidental possibilities include injuries from rope burns, excessive sun burn, tripping and falling, boat accidents, and heat exhaustion.

CHASE staff is trained in preventing accidents, first aid and CPR and prepared to assist in recognizing, reacting and responding to accidents, injuries and illness. Medical and search and rescue services are provided by the Coast Guard in response to an accident or emergency, however response times can be affected by location, weather or other emergencies and could be delayed.
